- Logos and trade names are permitted on first slide only because the purpose is education

### Slide Presentation Requirements:

#### Do:

- Use Microsoft PowerPoint with a font size 24 point or greater
- Use simple charts, graphs, and diagrams, instead of tables, to illustrate data
- If embedding videos into your presentation, please send video files to PMCA
- Submit 2-3 starter questions to [rachel.halkias@pmca.com](mailto:rachel.halkias@pmca.com)

#### Don't:

- Don't use script fonts or mix more than two font types on a slide
- Don't use excessive text (max. 7 words across and 7 lines down)
- Don't use all capital letters or all red text (hard to read)
- Don't use a company template (logo is limited to first slide only)
